Association of Public Health Laboratories - Building a Global One Health Community of Leaders for Laboratory System Strengthening and Health Security

Aim:

Strong laboratory leaders are essential for the development and maintenance of national laboratory systems capable of responding to today's health threats. The Global Laboratory Leadership Programme (GLLP) is a competency-based One Health laboratory leadership program with a laboratory system focus. The GLLP is the first One Health leadership program designed to support multisectoral partnerships and collaborations amongst all sectors in the laboratory system. The aim of this workshop is to enable GLLP implementation capacity through information and experience sharing.

Objectives:

- To provide an introduction to the GLLP - the Partners and the Programme
- A roadmap to GLLP implementation
- A description of the benefits of the GLLP for workforce development through experience sharing and success stories

Representatives from the GLLP founding partners and the Uganda, Ukraine and Vietnam programs will provide valuable information on their unique program models, successes and challenges with an emphasis on partnership building within a multisectoral national laboratory system.
