Management Sciences for Health - Combatting AMR in resource-constrained settings

This workshop will offer practical experience to healthcare professionals, public health officials, policy makers, donors and implementers on strategies to improve AMS and IPC in health facilities in resource-constrained settings. We will use case studies and scenarios from our implementation of AMS and IPC interventions in various countries to facilitate group discussions and generate practical recommendations that participants can then adapt for their local contexts.

Objectives:

- Describe practical low-cost strategies for the development and implementation of hospital antimicrobial stewardship (AMS) and infection prevention and control (IPC) programs in resource-constrained settings.
- Share lessons learned regarding the implementation and institutionalization of effective and complementary AMS and IPC interventions for improving antimicrobial use and patient safety in health facilities
- Share data-based improvement results from implementation of a continuous quality improvement program for AMS and IPC in Ethiopia and Uganda.
